The Village of Fife Lake-Downtown Development Authority (DDA) is accepting applications for the following, unpaid board vacancies:

Two-four (4) year terms ending on 12/31/29

DDA Board Member Duties:

- **Meeting Commitment:** Meetings are currently held the third Tuesday of the month at 6:30 p.m. at the Village Hall. Meeting dates and times plus location are established at the April Annual Meeting. Four quarterly meetings are required to be held in April, July, October and January. The DDA Board may hold additional meetings as needed.
- **Purpose and Responsibilities:** The Fife Lake DDA was established in 1993 under Michigan Public Act 197 of 1975 (MCL 125.4101a) to prevent property value deterioration, promote economic growth, and enhance the overall vitality of the DDA district through the use of tax increment financing.
- **Residency Requirement:** Not less than a majority of the members shall be persons having an interest in property located in the downtown district or officers, members, trustees, principals, or employees of a legal entity having an interest in property located in the downtown district.
